Montenero di Bisaccia



The first mobility of the project "**European Citizens of Tomorrow**" has been just concluded. The students from Macedonia, Portugal, Romania and Turkey have attended the first meeting in Montenero di Bisaccia, where, together with their Italian hosting partner, have practiced science activities created to accomplish the visual learning style.



In a joyful atmosphere, the students from 11 to 16 years old, have spent a week in Montenero di Bisaccia, welcomed by our organization staff: Mrs Paola Giordano, Mrs Stefania Del Nero, Mrs Alberta Sciarretta, Mr Roberto Tete, who have worked hard for preparing their arrival and then all days for the project meetings and the future development of the project. On the first day the official opening ceremony. All the partners' schools have presented their delegations, showing images from their countries and schools. The city Mayor, Mr. Nicola Travaglini received all the teachers in the City Hall and in the afternoon addressed the greetings of all the local community. The headmaster, Mrs Patrizia Ancora introduced Montenero School, together with the project coordinator, Mrs Paola Giordano. The event was closed by a short live musical performance of all the music teachers of the school who played a medley of movie soundtracks by Rota, Piovani and Morricone. At night all the local community welcomed the hosts

with an international dinner with all the traditional local dishes and where the hosts offered theirs.
